Diploid ryegrass tends to be shorter in height and a lighter colour compared to tetraploid ryegrass

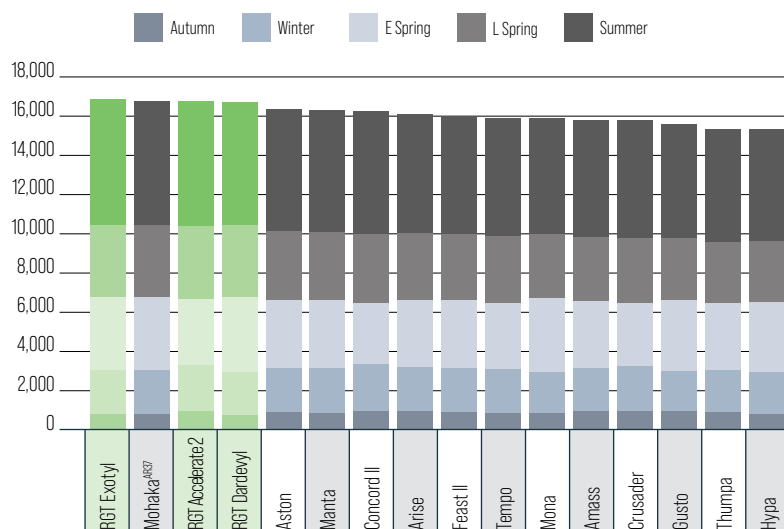

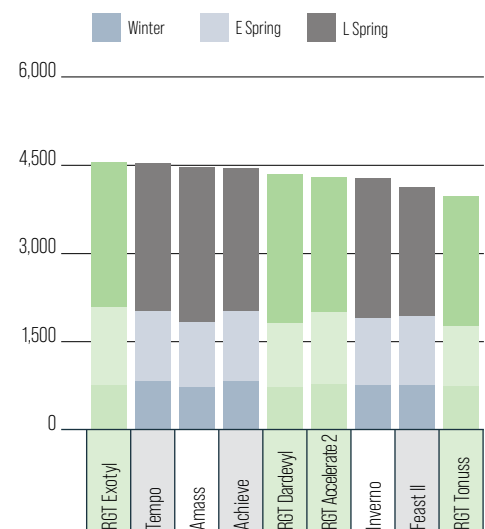
