## RGT MENVYL

RGT Menvyl is a high performing tetraploid annual ryegrass known for its improved leafiness and outstanding yield over Speedyl.

Replacing long-time favourite Speedyl, RGT Menvyl tetraploid annual ryegrass demonstrates higher yields than Speedyl over a wide range of seasons and environments.

It has improved autumn vigour, stable winter and spring growth whilst boasting improved leafiness over Speedyl.

RGT Menvyl tetraploid annual ryegrass has similar maturity to Speedyl (Late season) [+18] and low aftermath heading, with superior tolerance to leaf rust over Speedyl and other annual ryegrasses.

RGT Menvyl provides an excellent option as standalone quick feed with late quality, as part of a legume blend for forage conservation, or as an oversow variety to rejuvenate for tired old pastures.

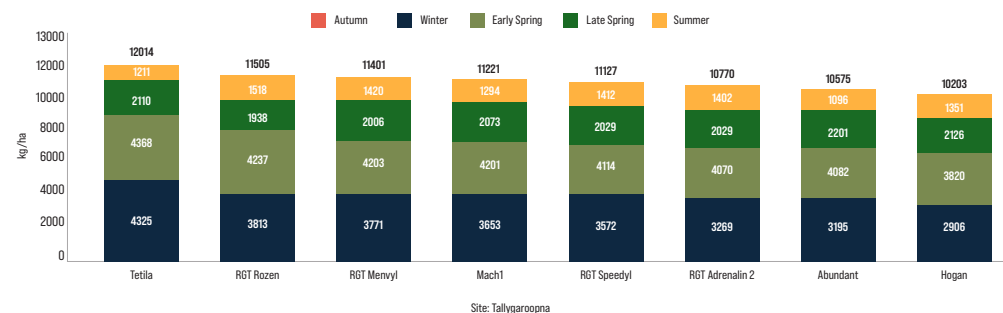

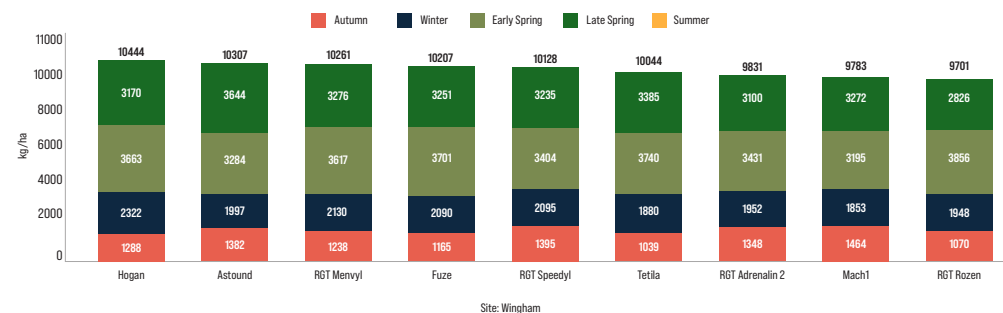

RGT Menvyl annual ryegrass has been a consistent performer across several seasons and sites including PTN data from 2019 Taree, 2021 Colac, 2022 Bairnsdale & Oaks and in 2023 at Aberdeen, Busselton, Peshurst, Lardner, Manjimup, Tallygaroopna & Wingham, As well as being entered at Cressy, Smeaton, Gommersal, Wingham & Franklin River in 2024.

The Pasture Trials Network (PTN) provides rigorous, independent, and free performance data on grazing forage varieties across temperate Australia, enabling livestock and dairy producers and their advisors to select the best pasture seed varieties for sowing.
